We collect data for the following purposes:

We retain data for at least seven years. For 501(c)(3) public charities, donor records must be kept for a minimum of five years in order to calculate the required public support test on IRS Form 990.

Our services are not intended for children under 18 years of age. We do not knowingly collect their data.
